### Summer Term 2021 – Information for Parents



We are excited to start up the Adventurers Youth Group again after the COVID lockdown and restrictions. This guidance is to give you all the details and information needed about how we plan to run the club for the summer term. If you have any questions, please do let us know. We would be happy to chat things through or help as needed.

#### Events and Parent Attendance

To ensure we run the club in the safest possible way we have planned the summer term events around being outside. This may mean that some events will only go ahead if the weather is suitable.

We will meet at the Church building on Grove Road. Children will only be allowed inside to use the toilet (which will be cleaned and operated under COVID secure procedures).

Parents will not be able to stay unless there is a specific requirement to be with your child. In this case social distancing and COVID guidelines must be followed for all adults present.

#### Drop off/Pick Up

To enable the session run well please follow the instructions below when dropping off/picking up:

- Please wait on the pavement outside the Church site with your child/children (following social distancing) until the welcome desk is free. When free, please enter and one of the leaders will register you for the club and for the covid track and trace details.
- Please then leave promptly to allow the next person to be registered.
- When collecting children at the end, please wait on the pavement until your child comes out and follow social distancing rules.

#### Group Size

We may be initially constrained in the numbers that we will be able to accommodate at Adventurers due to both available leaders and the guidance around out of school clubs.

To ensure we plan accordingly please can you respond each week before the event to the leaders (contact details below) to indicate if your children will be attending. We will be sending out reminders and the programme will be published (paper form and on our website).

We may, in some circumstances, need to limit the numbers – so please be aware there may need to be a waiting list applied for some events. We will let you know about this at the time but be aware that if you choose to turn up without letting us know, we may not always be able to accommodate you.

#### What to bring

We will initially be unable to provide any drinks/biscuits, so we ask that children bring their own drink if required.

Please bring suitable outdoor clothes (coats, waterproofs (if wet), jumpers & shoes that can be worn in the forest/mud).

We will of course keep these guidelines under review and will adapt what we provide in line with the available leaders and government guidelines. Thank you for your help and support. We know the kids will be super excited at being able to meet again and we hope we can enjoy a great summer term of activities.

### Further COVID Information

The key measures that we have in place in line with the relevant Government Guidance:

	Government Guidance	What are we doing?
1	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>minimising contact with individuals who are required to self-isolate by ensuring they do not attend the setting</li></ul>	If you need to self-isolate, please do not send your children to the group
2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>ensuring face coverings are used in recommended circumstances</li></ul>	All adults in any inside setting will wear face coverings
3	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>encouraging staff and children to clean their hands thoroughly and more often - soap or hand sanitiser should be readily available</li><li>ensuring good respiratory hygiene for everyone by promoting the 'catch it, bin it, kill it' approach</li><li>cleaning frequently touched surfaces more than usual</li><li>increased cleaning of toilets and washrooms</li><li>keeping occupied spaces well ventilated</li></ul>	Procedures in place to provide hand sanitising on arrival and whenever using the bathrooms. Cleaning and ventilation procedures in place for all indoor surfaces/spaces in use Keep all activities outside for the summer term NHS posters and reminders on display at the Church/registration
4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>using social distancing to reduce contact and mixing between groups of children</li><li>keeping children in the same bubbles they are in during the school day where possible, or otherwise in small, consistent groups</li></ul>	We will run all activities outside and minimise contact within the group during each event
5	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>promoting and engaging with the NHS Test and Trace process</li><li>managing and reporting confirmed cases of coronavirus (COVID-19)</li><li>containing any outbreak by following local health protection team advice</li></ul>	Posters and procedures to engage with NHS guidance. Keeping contact information and reporting any known confirmed cases to the group
